

## THE ULEZ IS COMING, BUT HOW WILL IT AFFECT YOU?

Do you operate in London and want to save money on the ultra low emissions zone (ULEZ) charges? Or do you just want to find out a bit more information and how it could affect you?

Then look no further, we have put together all key information for you so you can make an informed decision and save yourself or your business money!

### What is the ULEZ?

The Ultra Low Emission Zone (ULEZ) will replace the T-Charge from 8 April 2019. The daily charge runs from midnight to midnight, 7 days a week, every day of the year, within the same area as the current Congestion Charging Zone (CCZ).

### What does this mean for me?

This means increased costs to vehicles that don't meet the emissions criteria set out by the government! In total you could expect to pay up to £7800 per year per vehicle, this will cripple many companies and self-employed workers who operate within the capital!

### How much will it cost?

You can pay the ULEZ daily charge from 8 April 2019. It will be:

- £12.50 for most vehicle types, including cars, motorcycles and vans (up to and including 3.5 tonnes)
- £100 for heavier vehicles, including lorries (over 3.5 tonnes) and buses/coaches (over 5 tonnes)

From 25 October 2021 the area will expand to the inner London area bounded by the North and South Circular roads.

This means that EVERYONE within London will be affected not just the current congestion zone, we have attached a map so you can see the areas affected!
